The University of Nebraska is again offering scholarships for online courses through the Nebraska Virtual Scholars program. In support of Nebraska high schools, this year scholarships will be available for 150 courses through the University of Nebraska High School.

Through this program, UNHS works with high school administrators throughout the state to provide solutions to academic and staffing challenges. With these scholarships, schools can:

- Provide additional course offerings
- Keep students on the path to graduation
- Accelerate students
- Address teacher shortages
- Solve budget constraints

Scholarship Program Overview

- Each scholarship includes free tuition and materials for a .5 credit UNHS course.
- All Nebraska high schools are eligible.
- Scholarships will be awarded with an emphasis on meeting the needs of rural and/or underserved student populations.
- Applications will be accepted for fall, spring and summer enrollment.
- UNHS staff are available to provide support and consultation.

About UNHS

The University of Nebraska High School offers more than 100 core, elective and AP courses online. All courses are available 24/7, year-round so they fit any schedule. UNHS is accredited by the Nebraska Department of Education and AdvancED (North Central Association). Additionally, core and AP courses are approved by the NCAA.

Deadline

Applications will be accepted between August 1 – October 1, 2014. Schools will be notified whether or not they receive scholarships in mid-October.

Application Criteria

- Brief explanation of school’s current issue.
- Requested number of scholarships.
- Short description of how scholarships will solve the school’s issue.
- On-site support plan for scholarship integration (proctoring).
- Plan to measure impact of the program.
