

Intermediate Grammar

Course Description

This course challenges students with an in-depth study of grammar. Students review parts of speech and usage, sentence patterns, basic punctuation and capitalization. They study clauses, phrases and sentence problems; and complex pronoun, verb and adverb forms.

Course Objectives

- 1. Identify the parts of a sentence, the parts of speech, and the functions of the parts of speech and the parts of sentences.
- 2. Identify the patterns, purposes, and structures of sentences, as well as the elements that form the various sentence structures.
- 3. Identify verbals and verbal phrases used in sentences, as well as identify the functions and purposes of verbals and verbal phrases.
- 4. Identify, correct, and avoid such sentence problems as confusion of adverbs and adjectives, dangling modifiers, lack of parallelism, vague and indefinite pronoun usage.
- 5. punctuate sentences correctly.
