Course Description

This course is a comprehensive guide to writing, concentrating on the "6 + 1 Traits" of writing. The course contains six units, each devoted to a trait-Ideas, Organization, Sentence Fluency, Word Choice, Voice, and Convention. The optional trait of Presentation is also discussed. Students take objective assessments to measure their knowledge of the Six Traits and apply these skills in written projects. The course includes non-graded writing assignments that help students build the graded projects.

- 14. Write successful papers for different audiences.
- 15. Use proper spelling, punctuation, and grammar in your writing.
- 16. Cite sources correctly in a paper.
- 17. Apply effective layout and formatting to your papers.
