

Medical Terminology

Course Description

Medical Terminology course introduces you to the language of medicine. Through numerous activities, you will learn the meanings of word parts and spell, pronounce, break down, and build medical terms integral to the field of health sciences. This course is organized by body system and uses a workbookstyle textbook that covers essential root words, prefixes, suffixes, and abbreviations while also summarizing common diseases and disorders, diagnostic tests and procedures, and therapeutic treatments. This course will help you learn and practice using these terms as you interpret examples of medical records and become comfortable with the word parts you need to master in using medical terminology. Practical activities that involve medical record interpretation and healthcare case studies will bring medical terminology to life by offering you a window into the healthcare field.
