Course Description

This course reinforces and augments the grammatical concepts presented in First Year French. Students build new vocabulary, learn more advanced grammar concepts, increase their reading writing, and listening skills, and develop their knowledge of many essential parts of speech including the past tense and direct object pronouns and a number of commonly used French idioms and expressions.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: If students are to succeed, it is important that they be enrolled at the appropriate level. Therefore, students who have not been enrolled in our program and who want to enroll in French at this level are encouraged to take a placement test. To request a placement examination, contact customer service.

Course Objectives

By the time you have completed this course, you will have mastered certain skills and acquired certain types of understanding.

1. You will be able to recognize and use common French vocabulary in various grammatical structures.
2. You will be able to communicate using the past, present and future using these tenses of French verbs. You will also refine your ability to make suggestions and give commands. You will learn the passé récent, the futur proche, and the passé composé.
3. You will expand your ability to comprehend spoken French and to speak using more complex structures using refined pronunciation.
4. You will be able to read and write simple sentences and build them into narratives and conversations in French.
5. You will increase your knowledge of Francophone culture and daily life.
