Course Description

In this course, students take an imaginary tour of Paris and examine the United States from this vantage. After reviewing the grammar and rules presented in First and Second Year French, students study indirect objects; emphatic, interrogative and reflexive pronouns; and verbs in the reflexive voice, the imperfect tense and the conditional mood. Students continue to enhance their reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills.

Special Requirement: If students are to succeed, it is important that they be enrolled at the appropriate level. Therefore, students who have not been enrolled in our program and who want to enroll in French at this level are encouraged to take a placement test. To request a placement examination, contact customer service.

Graded Assessments: 4 Unit Evaluations, 3 Projects, and 3 Progress Tests

Course Objectives

1. You will be able to recognize and use common French vocabulary in various grammatical structures.
2. You will be able to use the present, past, future, and imperfect tenses of French verbs, as well as the imperative and conditional moods.
3. You will improve your ability to write complex sentences in French using the language tools you have learned.
4. You will improve your ability to read and write in French.
5. You will continue to develop your listening and speaking skills.
