Course Description

The readings for this course are based on the founding of Rome and its early history as a monarchy and then a republic. The grammar includes pronouns, passive voice of verbs, infinitives, adverbial expressions, participles, deponent verbs and indirect statements. Students are provided with numerous opportunities to practice individual grammar concepts and to use their developing vocabulary skills. By the end of this course, students will have a firm grasp of basic Latin grammar and an extensive Latin vocabulary. Audio files are embedded in the online course and are also available on an Audio CD for offline use.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: If students are to succeed, it is important that they be enrolled at the appropriate level. Therefore, students who have not been enrolled in our program and who want to enroll in Latin at this level are encouraged to take a placement test. Placement tests are available for online enrollment and submission.

Course Objectives

When you have completed the materials in this course, you should be able to:

1. Identify parts of speech such as nouns, verbs, prepositions, conjunctions, adjectives, and adverbs.
2. Write and use numerals and numbers in Latin.
3. Use the genitive and ablative cases in description.
4. Use each Latin case correctly and in the proper constructions, both with and without prepositions.
5. Identify and conjugate verbs in all four conjugations as well as numerous irregular verbs.
6. Form and use tenses correctly.
7. Identify and use the four principal parts of Latin verbs.
8. Form compound verbs and use the dative with them.
9. Use the dative case with intransitive verbs.
10. Use impersonal passives.
